Report of the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights on the implementation of Human Rights Council resolution 6/30 on “Integrating the human rights of women throughout the United Nations system”^{*}

Note by the Secretariat

1. In its resolution 6/30, the Human Rights Council requested the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights to report on the obstacles and challenges to the implementation of the resolution by the Human Rights Council and to make concrete recommendations for action to address obstacles and challenges encountered.
2. Member States and non-governmental organizations have provided important input in response to the Note Verbale sent by the Office in view of the preparation of the report for the eleventh session. However, following discussions with the main cosponsor of Council resolution 6/30, it has been agreed that the report will be submitted to the twelfth session of the Council, which will allow for the reflection of recent events, such as the plenary panel debate on women’s rights to be held during the eleventh session, and which will also coincide with the tabling and discussion of the resolution on the integration of human rights of women by the Human Rights Council in September 2009.
